Dear Parents,

In order to simplify our dress code and make it easier for all students to follow, we have implemented the following changes for the 2017 – 2018 school year.

Girls:

- “Khaki” style pants (Navy or Tan ONLY)- (No colored jeans/denim/jeggings/sweatpants/leggings or pajamas)
- All shirts must be a **Collared Button Down Shirt** (short or long sleeves) – **Colors allowed: White, Navy and Light Blue ONLY**. Must cover chest and midriff; **Shirts/sweaters may not be lace and no tank tops. Must be able to button shirt completely(no opened shirts w/tank tops)**
- Girls are not required to wear a scarf or ties.
- Dress shoes (flats – no flip flops or house slippers), boat shoes or sneakers are ok.
- **Only Global Hoodies allowed**, (No fleeces or jackets of any kind, including Global)
- No Hats, hair bonnets, hair nets, etc. (except for religious, medical reasons)

Boys:

- “Khaki” style pants (Navy or Tan ONLY) - (No colored jeans/denim/sweatpants/ or pajamas).
- Belts must be worn & adjusted to hold pants @ waist level
- No undergarments may be exposed
- All shirts must be collared button down shirts (short or long sleeve) – **Solid Colors Only: White, Navy and Light Blue ONLY** and tucked in.
- Boys must wear a tie
- Dress shoes, boat shoes, and sneakers are ok.

Gym Dress Code:

Boys and Girls Gym Dress Code:

- Crew neck T-shirts
- Sneakers and Socks
- Gym/Basketball Shorts(no denim) must be within 2” of the knee
- Appropriate Undergarments (non-revealing)
- No piercings for safety reasons

All Students:

- Must maintain healthy and safe hygiene and clothes must be clean

- No clothing that promotes weapons, alcohol, drugs, racism, violence, representation of gang activity including the wearing of colors, sexual content, bullying, harassment, intimidation or profanity
- Small/discrete facial piercings are allowed at **student and parent own risk** but must be removed for gym.
- No bare midriffs
- No baggy, low rise, multi-colored, or pants with holes are allowed
- No hats, bandannas, **hoodies/fleeces**, do-rags, jackets, or outerwear may be worn inside the building(exception for religious or medical reasons)
- No visible tattoos, fake tattoos, painted, colored, or marked skin (except for medical, religious, or cultural tradition)
- All acceptable clothing must be clean, properly sized, and appropriate for the day's weather conditions.

In addition, when on school property or at a school function, a student's dress, grooming and appearance, jewelry, make-up, will:

- Be safe, appropriate and not disrupt or interfere with the educational process.
- Be clean and neat
- Include footwear at all times. Footwear that is a safety hazard will not be allowed.
- Not include the wearing of headwear (including but not limited to hats, visors, caps, do-rags, bandanas, and hoods) of any kind in the classroom except for medical or religious purposes.
- Not include wearing of outside jackets in the school building except for entering or leaving the building.
- Not include the wearing of hazardous jewelry (including but not limited to spiked jewelry, collars, bracelets and wallet chains).

Any student not in dress code for the upcoming 2017-2018 School Year, will be required to call home for a change of clothes. If that student is unable to change into our dress code, he/she will be subject to disciplinary action.
