



### **High School Dress Code - 2019-2020**

Building administrators will be responsible for informing the students and their parents of the student dress code at the beginning of the school year and revisions to the dress code made during the school year. Students who violate the student dress code will be required to call home first, for a change of clothing or modify their appearance by covering or removing the item and, if necessary or practical, replacing it with an acceptable item. Any student who refuses to do so will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with this Code of Conduct.

All students are expected to arrive to school in appropriate dress code. Students and their parents have the primary responsibility to ensure acceptable student dress and appearance. **Teachers and all other personnel should exemplify and reinforce acceptable student dress, and help students develop an understanding of appropriate appearance at school.**

**Students are required to follow the mandatory dress code as follows:**

\*Global CREW NECK sweatshirt ONLY are allowed to be worn. The Global Crew Neck sweatshirts will be available for sale in the high school's main office for \$20 each. Previous senior hoodies, previous 8th grade hoodies, previous Global hoodies, and any other hoodies are NOT to be worn.

#### **Girls:**

- **"Khaki" style pants (Navy, Black or Tan ONLY)- (No colored jeans/denim/jeggings/sweatpants/leggings or pajamas)**
- Skirts and shorts are to be knee length or longer
- All shirts must be a **Button down Shirt, collared shirt only.** (short or long sleeves) – **Colors allowed: White, Blue and Light Blue ONLY.** Must cover chest and midriff, and shoulders. **Shirts/sweaters may not be lace and NO TANK TOPS.**
- **Abyas must be black, tan, navy, light blue or white. (scarves may be any color or pattern)**
- Sweaters may be V-neck or cardigan style (any color). **You must have a button down, collared shirt under sweater.**
- Flat dress shoes, boat shoes or sneakers required. (no slide-ons or house shoes, or slippers).
- **(No Fleece, No Game T-Shirts, No Game Jackets or Warmup, No Sports Attire or Track Jackets)**
- **Students will not be allowed to wear 8th grade hoodies or senior hoodies from previous years, or hoods of any kind.**
- No hats, hair bonnets, hair nets or do-rags etc. (except for religious, medical, or cultural tradition)

#### **Boys:**

- **"Khaki" style pants (Navy, Black or Tan ONLY) - (No colored jeans/denim/sweatpants/ or pajamas).**
- Belts must be worn & adjusted to hold pants @ waist level
- No undergarments may be exposed

- All shirts must be collared button down Oxford style shirts (short or long sleeve) – **Solid Colors Only: White, Blue and Light Blue ONLY** and tucked in.
- Boys must wear ties or bow tie
- Sweaters may be V-neck or cardigan style (any color) Collared, Button down shirt must be under sweater.
- Dress shoes, boat shoes or sneakers are required. **No slide-ons, house shoes, or slippers.**
- **Global CREW NECK sweathshirts are allowed only - (No Fleece, No Game T-Shirts, No Game Jackets or Warmup, No Sports Attire or Track Jackets)**
- No hats, hair bonnets, hair nets or do-rags etc. (except for religious, medical, or cultural tradition)

### Gym Dress Code

Boys and Girls Gym Dress Code:

- Sneakers
- all students need to bring and change into an appropriate change of clothing for a physical education class.

### All Students:

- Must maintain healthy and safe hygiene and clothes must be clean
  - No clothing that promotes weapons, alcohol, drugs, racism, violence, representation of gang activity including the wearing of colors, sexual content, bullying, harassment, intimidation or profanity
  - Small/discrete facial piercings are allowed at student and parent own risk but must be removed for gym.
  - No bare midriffs, chest, or shoulders.
  - No baggy, low rise, multi-colored, nor pants with holes are allowed
  - No hats, bandanas, **hoodies/fleeces**, do-rags, jackets, or outerwear may be worn inside the building(exception for religious or cultural reasons)
  - All acceptable clothing must be clean, properly sized, and appropriate for the day's weather conditions.

**In addition, when on school property or at a school function, a student's dress, grooming and appearance, jewelry, make-up and nails, will:**

- Be safe, appropriate and not disrupt or interfere with the educational process.
- Be clean and neat
- Include footwear at all times. Footwear that is a safety hazard will not be allowed.
- Not include the wearing of headwear (including but not limited to hats, visors, caps, do-rags, bandanas, and hoods) of any kind in the classroom except for medical or religious purposes.
- Not include wearing of outside jackets in the school building except for entering or leaving the building.
- Not include the wearing of hazardous jewelry (including but not limited to spiked jewelry, collars, bracelets and wallet chains).

### **BACKPACK POLICY:**

*Students are allowed to bring any backpack that they choose, to school. If it is not clear or mesh, it must go into their locker for the day. If a student would like to carry his or her backpack throughout the day, it must be clear or mesh. Students are able to go to their lockers during change of class, to get any needed supplies. Students will be allowed to carry small purses/bags (approximately the size of a tissue box).*
